## Flexible care and support

The on-site support at Oak Close is provided by a team of experts from Rotherham Doncaster and South Humber NHS Foundation Trust who are available whenever you need them.

South Yorkshire Housing Association's SAMS (Support and Management Service) will work with you throughout your tenancy to ensure you that you are happy, your needs are met and the appropriate care and support is being delivered.

## Eligibility and applying for a place

Oak Close is owned and managed by South Yorkshire Housing Association and is part of our LiveWell group of services across the region.

Our LiveWell services help people to settle at home, live well and realise their potential and that's what Oak Close is all about.

To be eligible for a place at Oak Close you must live in Rotherham and be aged 18 or over and be living with a learning disability.
