Introducing and Profiling the District

TED originally attempted coproduction by appointing people aged 50 and over to a scrutiny group that would link to decision making regarding services. We have found the language of 'scrutiny' and a formal coproduction body created limitations. Through 'grass roots' community practice we have:

- Understood and reached people who are central to TED in East Lindsey, but would not have engaged in formal coproduction through the Steering Group.

-Have enabled representatives with 'lived experience' to be part of the Programme Management Group.

-Have recognised the role of frontline delivery and dedicated resource in also acting as proxies of community need and preferences.
