

Q&A with the Age of Experience Group Robert

1) How long have you been a member of the Age of Experience group and what motivated you to join?

About 2.5 years. This was shortly after I retired and was looking for new experience in the next stage of my life. I had been aware of the Ageing Better Programme from its earliest beginnings. I identify as a gay man and one of the streams is aimed at the LGBT community and I felt it important to support this initiative.
