Service eligibility

Beaufort Projects supports people with mental health issues who:

- are aged 18+
- require support to develop long term independent living skills
- are willing, or require assertive encouragement, to engage with the support service
- are engaged with treatment and other services that support their mental health issue
- require a period of stable supported accommodation to gain independent living skills and confidence following discharge from hospital or residential care
- need structured supported accommodation to prevent the need for high level hospital or residential care
- have the potential and the capability to move on within a 2-year period

Guiding Principles

The delivery of the service will be centred on achieving successful outcomes for customers to:

- Have economic well-being
- Enjoy their life, and achieve their goals
- Stay safe and healthy
- Make a positive contribution
- Find accommodation, and to settle and thrive in their new home

Customers will be integral to the planning and delivery of the service, and their views will be listened to and discussed to shape the support they receive.

The service promotes Trauma Informed Practice and a Psychologically Informed Environment (PIE) where the programme of support has been designed to take the psychological and emotional needs of customers into account.

Service Delivery

Moving on to independent living is the goal from the start of support, and options will be explored from the beginning. Beaufort Project will work closely with other professionals and agencies to provide a co-ordinated personalised service which meets the identified needs of the person, and promotes their recovery.
