Flexible care and support

The Lister Project has an on-site team of specialist staff available 24-hours a day. As a customer you'll regularly meet with your named keyworker who will ensure that you are happy, your needs are met and the appropriate care and support is being delivered.

If you like we'll also build in regular contact with your family, friends or carers.

Eligibility and applying for a place

The Lister Project is owned and managed by South Yorkshire Housing Association and is part of our LiveWell group of services across South Yorkshire.

To be eligible for a place at the Lister Project you must be on the Care Programme Approach and have contact with a care team.

Referrals are accepted from local Community Mental Health Teams and hospitals.
