Life with LivingWell

Our support workers will work with you to build your confidence and learn key skills you'll need to move into your own property. You can access support in a range of areas including:

- Help to move into your home
- Managing your tenancy
- Decorating your home
- Access to education and volunteering

Flexible care and support

Our staff work closely with experts from SHSC and are trained to support people with a variety of needs, including mental health problems, personality disorder or mild learning disabilities.

We'll work with you throughout your tenancy to ensure you that you are happy, your needs are met and the appropriate care and support is being delivered.

Eligibility and applying for a place

The LivingWell project is managed by South Yorkshire Housing Association and is part of our LiveWell group of services.

To be eligible for a place with LivingWell you must be aged 18 or over and be living with a learning disability, mental health problem or personality disorder.

All referrals to LivingWell come through SHSC's Community Enhancing Recovery Team, also known as CERT.
