Housing First Rotherham is for people who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, or sleeping rough in the Rotherham area.

Our service supports people who have multiple and complex needs, are experiencing barriers in ending their homelessness, and have struggled to maintain any other form of tenancy.

The Housing First model works by offering people a home first – this acts as a stable foundation for recovery and to rebuild their lives. Our customers are supported to settle in their home, and to make choices about how they'd like to build on their strengths and meet their goals.

We work in partnership with local organisations to offer our customers holistic and personalised support.

We aim to provide our customers with a home for life. Wherever possible, our customers can stay in their home or be supported to move on to somewhere new when the time is right.

The support we offer

Our team of key workers have experience in working with people with a range of complex needs, including mental health problems, substance misuse and contact with the criminal justice system. They work with customers to improve their independent living skills, and offer flexible support for as long as it's needed.

Our support is available 9am-5pm, Monday to Friday.

Eligibility and making a referral

Housing First Rotherham is a partnership between South Yorkshire Housing Association and Target.

To be eligible for a referral to Rotherham Housing First you must be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, and desire to have a tenancy. We accept referrals from local authorities, and other local services and voluntary organisations.
