What do we offer?

The Rotherham Thursday Project provides housing related support to those who have recently experienced a period of homeless or are at significant risk of homelessness. We offer:

- Specialist advice on how to maintain your tenancy
- Support that lasts up to two years
- A named keyworker who'll work with you on a one-to-one basis
- Personal support based on your individual needs
- A wide range of social activities for you to get involved in

Life at Rotherham Thursday Project

Customers at the Rotherham Thursday Project enjoy a rich and active social life. You can get involved in a range of activities including:

- Walking groups
- IT workshops
- Healthy eating sessions
- Volunteering

Flexible care and support

You'll initially meet with your keyworker for at least two and

a half hours a week. As your confidence grows sessions will become less frequent – most of our customers are confident enough to move on within six months.

Your keyworker will ensure that you are happy, your needs are met and the appropriate care and support is being delivered. They will work with you to set achievable goals and reach the ambitions you have.

Eligibility and applying for a place

The Rotherham Thursday Project is owned and managed by South Yorkshire Housing Association and is part of our LiveWell group of services across South Yorkshire.

Anyone can be referred to Rotherham Thursday Project. You can even self-refer yourself. You must be aged 16 or above to be eligible for our support.
