# Covid-19 Peer Research Volunteer Role

### **Summary of the Role**

We're looking for people to volunteer with us and capture the stories and experiences of how Coronavirus has affected our customers throughout lockdown and beyond.

You'll work as part of a team with fellow volunteers to gather feedback from customers who live in our general rent, and care and supported housing properties. The feedback will be used by South Yorkshire Housing Association staff to write a report that will help us to determine whether we got it right for our customers throughout Covid-19.

We'd particularly welcome applications from South Yorkshire Housing Association customers, and/or people who are classed as vulnerable to Coronavirus, have been shielding, or have experienced the impact of others shielding.

You'll conduct your research from home using Microsoft Teams video chat, and you'll need access to home WiFi or access to a mobile data hotspot to carry out the video calls.

We'll provide you with a Chromebook device, South Yorkshire Housing Association user account, and all the relevant training you need to get started.

You won't be out of pocket whilst volunteering with us, and we'll discuss potential expenses when we meet.

- Able to handle difficult conversations
- Basic IT skills

- Complete South Yorkshire Housing Associations training package via
   Microsoft teams and our Safety media E-Learning Package
- Meet your fellow volunteers and discuss how you'd like to conduct the research

- Contact South Yorkshire Housing Association customers via Teams, carry out and record conversations and save to our departmental SharePoint site
- Discuss your findings via Teams, with other researchers and keep in touch with the Volunteering Team throughout the project.

- We'll provide all the necessary training so you can use your device, conduct your research and keep in touch

- We'll provide you with a certificate highlighting your involvement with us
