At Stonelow Court we work with people aged 55 or over to live as independently as possible. We offer:

- Two bedroom self-contained flats finished to a high standard
- Fully fitted level access shower and kitchen
- Access to on-site café, laundry, communal lounge and activity room
- Regular visits from a hairdresser
- Alarm call system with on-site response
- CCTV security
- Your own front door it's your home!

Flexible care and support

At Stonelow Court you'll have a named keyworker who will work with you to ensure you are happy, your needs are met, and that you feel safe and secure in your home.

Our aim is to give you the confidence you need to live independently and stay healthy. We'll also work with you to:

- Access other health and social care support
- Manage your finances
- Discover new skills and talents
- Develop new friendships
- Engage in the wider community.

What can I get involved in?

You can take part in a range of resident-led social and leisure activities, including:

- Exercise activities
- Computer sessions
- Working with children
- Music groups.

Eligibility and applying for a place

Stonelow Court is owned and managed by South Yorkshire Housing Association. We work with people to settle at home, live well and realise their potential.

We accept referrals from a range of sources including council housing services, social workers, GPs and community nurses. You can also self-refer into Stonelow Court.

To be eligible for a place at Stonelow Court you must be aged over 55 at the time of application, live in the Derbyshire area and have a supported housing need.
